4	Department of Agriculture falls under the Committee on Rules, Natural Resources, Federal, Foreign			
5	and Micronesian Affairs; and			
6	WHEREAS, oversight of law enforcement functions traditionally fall under the purview of a			
7	Public Safety/Law Enforcement Committee; and			
8	WHEREAS, it is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to ensure that the oversight of the			
9	Conservation Officers and their law enforcement function also fall under the Committee on Public			
10	Safety, Law Enforcement and Senior Citizens; and			
11	WHEREAS, Rule XVII, Section 17.09, I mina Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan Standing			
12	Rules is hereby amended to read:
