- 3 WHEREAS, William "Bill" R. Roth was born on August 11, 1951 to
- 4 Philip and Joan Roth in Chicago, Illinois and is married to Ann Marie
- 5 O'Mallan Roth, together they have four (4) children, William, Christina,
- 6 Mariana and Kenneth; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Roth received his Bachelor of Arts degree, in History,
- 8 from Christian Brothers College, Memphis, TN in 1973, and a Master's degree,
- 9 in History, from Memphis State University, Memphis, TN in 1975; and

- 1 WHEREAS, in February 1977, Mr. Roth found his way to the island of
- 2 Guam and began his career with the Catholic Schools of Guam with a position
- 3 at Notre Dame High School in Talofofo teaching courses in History,
- 4 Accounting and Sociology; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in 1978, Mr. Roth was given the added responsibility of
- 6 handling the finances of the school, and in the following year, 1979, was
- 7 promoted to the position of Vice Principal, which he maintained for the next
- 8 twelve (12) years; and
- 9 WHEREAS, in June 1991, Mr. Roth was appointed to the position of
- 10 Principal of Father Duenas Memorial High School (FDMS) in Mangilao, a
- 11 position he holds today; and
- WHEREAS, in August 1992, Super Typhoon Omar ravaged the campus
- of FDMS and, thus, began the reconstruction phase of FDMS; and
- 14 **WHEREAS**, within two years after the destruction of the campus, under
- 15 the leadership and guidance of Mr. Roth, the FDMS faculty, staff and students
- 16 unveiled and dedicated a newly built quad and renovated cafeteria building,
- 17 which still exists today; and
- 18 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Roth, having foresight and wisdom, saw the need for
- 19 additional classrooms and a new and bigger gym to continue to provide the
- 20 proper environment for academic learning and sports program for the
- 21 increasing student population; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, Mr. Roth, along with the FDMS community, broke ground on the Phoenix Center, the long-awaited multi-purpose sports facility

equipped with air conditioned classrooms, weight room, state-of-the-art stage

4 and a hard-wood floor gym; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Roth, together with tremendous support and hard work from the staff and alumni, spearheaded fundraising projects to help defray the cost of the \$2.9 million Phoenix Center; and

WHEREAS, in February 9, 2007, Mr. Roth and the FDMS Family, former and present members, watched with great pride as Archbishop Anthony Apuron bless the Phoenix Center during its grand opening celebration; and

WHEREAS, throughout the past thirty-two (32) years, Mr. Bill Roth's dedication and commitment to education, has positively impacted and contributed to the development, progress and success of the students and education; now, therefore, be it
