WHEREAS, it is acknowledged by *I Liheslaturan* that the month of May is the local and national recognized month to celebrate "Mental Health Awareness Month" to raise awareness of mental health and eliminate discrimination against people with mental illness;

WHEREAS, the year 2009 marks the Twenty-eight Anniversary of the Guam Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse created through the enactment of Public Law 17-21 in 1983, and this year's theme is "Live Your Life Well"; and

WHEREAS, one in every five Americans experiences a mental health disorder in any given year , but only one-third seek care due to the stigma and misperceptions surrounding mental disorders and their treatment; and

WHEREAS, more and more Americans are suffering due to the increasing economic troubles piled on by stress or work and family demands; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Mental Health & Substance Abuse encourage the community to get involved in mental health month activities by wearing green ribbons to support this month's events; and

WHEREAS, various activities are being coordinated throughout the month of May 2005 to commemorate this event, including a proclamation signing at Governor's Conference room in Adelup, Consumer Voices Workshop, an open house, groundbreaking for St. Dymphna Memorial Park followed by a mass held at the DMHSA Tamuning facility, a tree planting ceremony for DMHSA Fruit Tree Garden and a grand opening of Healing Hearts Crisis Center at 215 Duenas Drive in Tamuning; and now, therefore, be it
