As the GATE Coordinator, she produced Kids on the Block - a disability awareness puppetry theater, acquired the GATE Tiyan Theater in 1995, created the GATE High School Performing Arts Program, the GATE Honor Choir, expanded the GATE elementary school program in every school and initiated the Pickled Papaya, GATE's annual compilation of elementary visual arts student work and poetry from elementary GATE resource room students.

WHEREAS, Ms. Teri Knapp also served our community and brought pride to our island by creating and coordinating the Children's' Productions in 1982, the much awarded and highly acclaimed SKIP or "Sunshine Kids in Production" in 1984, and, the Summer Summersault Camp for teens for 13 consecutive summers; and
