WHEREAS, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was born on September 18, 1954 in Talafofo. Her parents are Rita Tudela and Juan B. Castro. Married to Joseph N. Borja and is the proud mother of Barbara Jean Taijeron, Jolyn Michelle Taijeron, Joseph Michael Reyes, Jeffrey James Reyes & Joyce Maria Reyes ; and

WHEREAS, Jacintha Tudela Reyes, affectionately known to all as "Cindy" is a loving grandmother to Kenny Jr., Keara Jean, Kisha Josette, Jonea Lynn (Taijeron) Kylie Jade, Heaven Marie, Jude Ryan, Evangeline Cynthia, Christopher Joseph, Christian Jay, Jade Lynn & Jadene Cynthia Reyes; and

WHEREAS, Jacintha Tudela Reyes began her professional career as a substitute teacher with the Department of Education in 1974 to 1976 and worked at Floral Fauna Title IV Project in 1977 to 1978 ; and

WHEREAS, On January 1, 1979 Jacintha Tudela Reyes began her employment with the Department of Public Health and Social Services as an Assistance Payment Worker I ; and

WHEREAS, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was promoted the following year in 1980 and was given the Assistance Payment Worker II position while serving the Aid to the Families with Dependent Children Program (AFDC) and then later promoted as supervisor ; and

WHEREAS, In 1984, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was promoted to Assistance Payment Worker III which was later on reclassified to Eligibility Specialists, making Cindy an Eligibility Specialist Supervisor in 1985 ; and

WHEREAS, Jacintha Tudela Reyes worked with the Division of Public Welfare , Bureau of Management Support Services (1979), Bureau of Economic Security (1979- 1983), Medically Indigent Program (1983-1987), Bureau of Health Care Financing (1987-1997) and Bureau of Economic Security (1997- 2009) ; and

WHEREAS, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was detailed twice in March and July of 1991 as the Social Services Supervisor 1 for the Bureau of Economic Security on top of her position as an Eligibility Specialist; and

WHEREAS, In 1995, Jacintha Tudela Reyes was awarded the Supervisor of the Year and the Employee of the Year of the Department of Public Health and Social Services, validating her years of hard work and her ability to manage staff effectively; and

WHEREAS, Jacintha Tudela Reyes or "Cindy", an avid bowler, loyal to the Catholic Church and most especially to her family, has assisted countless numbers of people during her 30 years in service as government of Guam employee ; therefore be it,
