Japanese invasion and occupation, this young Chamorro girl was Mariana's

WHEREAS, Mariana's project highlighted the struggles of the Chamorro People's spirit of hope and strength as they overcame the oppression they experienced during the war; and

WHEREAS, Mariana's project impressed judges of the National History
Day completion and was presented the "State Outstanding Entry" award and was a
