WHEREAS, throughout the 1970s, the Department of Public Safety,

under the leadership of Director Jose Quintanilla, worked in the establishment

of a Crime Laboratory Section; and

WHEREAS, establishment of the Crime Lab section of the Department

of Safety, later changed to the Guam Police Department, was not a simple task

that required time to educate our local law enforcement officers, the

recruitment of experts in the field, and a strong leadership that would allow

the Crime Lab section to grow to fruition and reach its full potential; and

WHEREAS, today the Crime Lab section of the Guam Police

Department, coming a long way from its humble beginnings, has served our

community as well as our Micronesia neighbors providing services - such as a

strong crime scene investigation, fingerprint identification, drug identification, and firearms identification – that ensure the safety of our island and regional community; and

WHEREAS, in early 2009, a new building was dedicated for the enhancement of the Crime Lab's ability to prosecute and investigate crimes in order to guarantee the resolution of crimes; and

WHEREAS, the realization that more improvement can be made to the Crime Lab and the services that it provides, the establishment of a non-profit organization was envisioned and "the Friends of the Crime Lab, Inc." was founded to assist and enhance the delivery of quality forensic science services, to provide supportive services, program services, equipment, training and activities to meet the needs of the crime lab, to facilitate and strengthen collaboration and partnership efforts with both public and private sectors, to increase the availability of forensic science services, to seek, pursue and solicit other funding sources through grants, corporate sponsorships, donations, fundraisers and other resources for "FRIENDS" in furtherance of the organization's purpose to provide resources for the Guam Crime Lab; and

WHEREAS, the Friends of the Crime Lab, Inc. estimates that an additional \$5 million is needed to fully bring the Crime Lab to its standard of expectation and to allow for further services such as DNA and toxicology; and

WHEREAS, the Friends of the Crime Lab, Inc.'s mission is to also provide educational opportunities to enhance the knowledge base of our local law enforcement officials, and thus coordinated the 1st Regional Forensic Science Symposium held on November 4-6, 2009 at the Harvest Christian

Academy Family Life Center; and
