WHEREAS, in 1904 a young New York City court clerk named Ernest
Coulter, set out in search for caring adults to assist the many boys and girls
coming through his courtroom, marking the beginning of the movement and

6 mission of what would eventually become the modern-day Big Brothers Big

Sisters Organization; and

WHEREAS, the mission of Big Brothers Big Sisters has been to help children reach their prospective goals, as it continues to be the leader in one-to-one youth service for more than a century, developing positive relationships that have a direct and long lasting impact on the lives of young

1 people, mentoring children ages six through eighteen; and

WHEREAS, the mentoring programs of Big Brothers Big Sisters – which have been endorsed by Presidents and First Ladies, including Theodore Roosevelt, Calvin Coolidge, Bill Clinton, Laura Bush, and Barack and Michelle Obama, have shown through national research that positive relationships between youth and their Big Brothers Big Sisters mentors have a direct and measurable impact on children's lives. By participating in youth mentoring programs, Little Brothers and Sisters are 46% less likely to begin using illegal drugs, 27% less likely to begin using alcohol and 52% less likely to skip school; and 

WHEREAS, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Guam seeks to provide the same quality volunteer and professional mentoring services for children and youth and to assist the children in achieving their highest potential as they grow to become responsible men and women; and

WHEREAS, the corporate mentoring partners with Big Brothers Big Sisters of Guam have devoted their time and efforts to positively influence students around the island; and

WHEREAS, students attending Price Elementary School, Carbullido Elementary School, Upi Elementary School, Tamuning Elementary School; FB Leon Guerrero Middle School, Agueda Johnston Middle School, Untalan Middle School, Mount Carmel School, and Benavente Middle School were able to receive support through intervention and prevention programs, as well as educational and community involvement, allowing each child to achieve their potential and function in society with a greater degree of

confidence; and

WHEREAS, the community partners with Big Brothers Big Sisters of
Guam including the Department of Education, Department of Youth Affairs,
Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse, Community Services and
Resources and the Red Ribbon Committee, continue to promote the
accessibility of mentoring programs through various activities available at
their agencies by their persistent support, hard work and dedication; and

WHEREAS, individual volunteers and members of voluntary organizations have come forward to offer Big Brothers Big Sisters of Guam their services to work toward improving the lives of our children on the island of Guam; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules on behalf of the Guam Legislature and the people of Guam, recognize the month of February 2010 as "Mentor Awareness and Appreciation Month", and does urge the island community to actively participate in promoting greater understanding of mentoring a child; and does further commend the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Guam corporate and community partners and volunteers who have made great strides, who continue to help raise the awareness, and who without fail offer their support in mentoring a child; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Big Brothers Big Sisters of Guam; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, I' Magalahen Guahan.
