WHEREAS, since its inception in 1992, the Guam Child Care and Development Association (GCCDA) has dedicated itself to improving the lives of children and families on Guam through their focus on child development and the acknowledgement of the parents, teachers, caregivers and stakeholders who ensure the continuing growth and development of Guam's children; and

WHEREAS, this year's theme, "Beyond Quality Care: Promoting Healthy Behaviors in Young Children," tackles an important issue for the island and the nation as childhood obesity has tripled in the last 30 years. Many people in our island community battle health conditions such as high blood pressure, elevated cholesterol, type 2 diabetes, certain cancers, and heart disease; and
