
## I MINA' TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2010 (SECOND) REGULAR SESSION

Park, San Ramon Caves, Gåan Point, Manenggon Memorial Park and the Yigo
Pacific Peace Memorial Park in order to better understand the horrors of war
and its effects on both the soldiers who fought it and the innocent civilians
caught in its wake; and

WHEREAS, it is hoped that this will continue to be an annual trip, and that the tribute paid by these high school students will shine as an example that

will encourage other students and organizations from Japan to make similar
 trips; and

WHEREAS, U.S. Explore & Study, Inc., has been instrumental in trying to heal the wounds of World War II and tensions over the war between the people of Japan, Guam, and the United States, and has held ceremonies and tributes in the past years with that noble aim; and

WHEREAS, the *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, along with its president, Mr. Kensuke Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals and especially to help organize this trip by Japanese high school students; now, therefore, be it
