5 **WHEREAS**, a group of eighteen (18) high school students and their  
6 advisors from Japan visited Guam for the purpose of showing respect and  
7 prayer for those who died during World War II; and

8 **WHEREAS**, those students visited the War in the Pacific National  
9 Park, San Ramon Caves, Gåan Point, Manenggon Memorial Park and the Yigo  
10 Pacific Peace Memorial Park in order to better understand the horrors of war  
11 and its effects on both the soldiers who fought it and the innocent civilians  
12 caught in its wake; and

13 **WHEREAS**, it is hoped that this will continue to be an annual trip, and  
14 that the tribute paid by these high school students will shine as an example that

15 will encourage other students and organizations from Japan to make similar  
16 trips; and

17 **WHEREAS**, *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, has been instrumental in  
18 trying to heal the wounds of World War II and tensions over the war between  
19 the people of Japan, Guam, and the United States, and has held ceremonies and  
20 tributes in the past years with that noble aim; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the *U.S. Explore & Study, Inc.*, along with its president,  
22 Mr. Kensuke Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals  
23 and especially to help organize this trip by Japanese high school students; now,  
24 therefore, be it

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*  
26 *LiheSlaturan Guahan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, highly  
27 commend and thank the students, principal and teachers from Will-Gakuen of  
28 Gakuken Corporation for visiting Guam and the World War II sites, and  
29 honoring those who died at those sites, with their prayer and tribute; and be it
