3 WHEREAS, Captain Hill C. Leon Guerrero was born on Guam in  
4 January 14, 1969; and

5  
6 WHEREAS, Captain Leon Guerrero is married to the former Maria  
7 Liza C. Dalmacio. They have two beautiful children Hill Junior and Brynn  
8 Ellese; and

10 WHEREAS, Captain Leon Guerrero was commissioned a Second  
11 Lieutenant of Field Artillery upon graduation from the University of Guam  
12 in June 1991; and

14 WHEREAS, Captain Leon Guerrero completed the Field Artillery  
15 Officer Basic Course in 1993 and was assigned to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion, 7<sup>th</sup> Field  
16 Artillery "Never Broken" at Schofield Barracks, 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division  
17 (Light), Hawaii where he served as a Forward Observer for the 4<sup>th</sup>  
18 Battalion, 87<sup>th</sup> Infantry Brigade and later as a Fire Direction Officer, Platoon

1 Leader and Target Analyst for the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 8<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery  
2 “Automatic”; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in June 1996, Captain Leon Guerrero transitioned from  
5 Active Duty to the Individual Ready Reserves ; and

6  
7 **WHEREAS**, shortly there after, he started his civilian career in law  
8 enforcement as a Probation Officer at the Superior Court of Guam; and

9  
10 **WHEREAS**, in February 2003, Captain Leon Guerrero transitioned  
11 from the Individual Ready Reserves to the Army Reserves. He was  
12 assigned to the 1101<sup>st</sup> GSU DET-1, Guam and served as Transportation  
13 Section Chief; and

14  
15 **WHEREAS**, in August 2005, he was reassigned to the 80<sup>th</sup> Division  
16 (IT) in Richmond Virginia and deployed to Baghdad, Iraq where he served  
17 as the Assistant Team Chief and Team Chief for the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 3<sup>rd</sup> Public  
18 Order Brigade Special Police Transition Team and Assistant Team Chief for  
19 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion, 8<sup>th</sup> Brigade, 2<sup>nd</sup> National Police Division Special Police  
20 Transition Team; and

22 **WHEREAS**, on August 3, 2006, Captain Leon Guerrero was Released  
23 from Active Duty and reassigned to the 1101<sup>st</sup> GSU DET-1 Guam where he  
24 served as the Operation Officer; and

26 **WHEREAS**, Captain Leon Guerrero, in June 2007, assumed duties as  
27 the Operation Officer for the 9<sup>th</sup> Theatre Support Group (Prov.), Guam and  
28 on October 1, 2007, he was mobilized to Hawaii and assumed command of  
29 an active duty unit, Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, United  
30 States Army Garrison- Hawaii from November 5, 2007 to October 30, 2008 ;

1           **WHEREAS**, Captain Leon Guerrero was reassigned to the 322 Civil  
2 Affairs Brigade and served as a member of the Civil Affairs Team on Guam  
3 in January, 2009; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Captain Leon Guerrero's awards and decorations  
6 include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Army  
7 Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, National Defense  
8 Service Medal (2<sup>nd</sup> Award), Iraq Campaign Medal , Global War on  
9 Terrorism Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon (2<sup>nd</sup> Award), Armed Forces  
10 Reserve Medal (with M-Device), Combat Action Badge and the Air Assault  
11 Badge; now, therefore be it

14 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and welcome Captain
