RELATIVE TO CONGRATULATING THE GUAM BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS, ARCHITECTS AND LAND SURVEYORS (PEALS) AS THEY CELEBRATE FIFTY (50) YEARS OF SAFEGUARDING THE SAFETY AND WELFARE FOR THE PEOPLE OF GUAM AND OBSERVE AUGUST 23, 2010 TO AUGUST 27, 2010 AS "PEALS WEEK".

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

2 WHEREAS, the Territorial Board of Engineering and Architectural Examiners

was created in 1960 by Public Law 5-131 to promote public welfare by regulating the

4 practice of engineering and architecture;

5 WHEREAS, in 1986 the name of the Board was changed to "Territorial Board of

6 Registration for Professional Engineers, Architects and Land Surveyors Board (PEALS)"

by Public Law 18-43;

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8 WHEREAS, in 1998, Public Law 24-263 was enacted to fully define the Board's

9 functions and to update the rules and regulations in accordance with the policies of

jurisdictional Boards and in the professional environment within Guam; giving the Board

authority to issue citations and fines to unlicensed individuals and business firms engaged

in the unlawful practice of engineering, architecture and land surveying;

WHEREAS, Public Law 30-35 was adopted and implemented in July 2009 to

strengthen the provisions of the registration law and enforcement powers to uphold the

integrity of the professions and has additionally regulated the practice of landscape

16 architecture:

1	WHEREAS, the Board qualifies and licenses individuals, establishes regulations,
2	enforces laws and regulations, and provides information to the public;
3	WHEREAS, after ten (10) years, in 1973 the Board has additionally regulated the
4	practice of land surveying profession, and administered its first fundamentals and
5	principles exams;
6	WHEREAS, the PEALS Board has established its goals and objectives which
7	provide the framework to achieve the furtherance of its mission:
8	• Ensure the professional qualifications of those practicing engineering,
9	architecture, land surveying and landscape architecture by setting
10	requirements for education, experience and examination;
11	• Establish regulatory standards of practice for those registered as
12	professional engineers, architects, land surveyors and landscape architects.
13	• Requiring that any person practicing or offering to practice engineering,
14	architecture, land surveying and landscape architecture be licensed and
15	registered; and
16	• Protect consumers by preventing violations and effectively enforcing laws,
17	codes and standards when violations occur.
18	WHEREAS, in April 1990 the Guam PEALS Board hosted the National Council
19	of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) Western Zone meeting, attended
20	by representatives of United States jurisdictional Boards;
21	WHEREAS, the PEALS Board continues to assist the Department of Public
22	Works – Building Permits Inspection Division by making sure that only the applicable
23	seal shall be used or applied on plans and drawings signed by licensed professionals;
24	now, therefore, be it
25	RESOLVED, that I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf
26	of the people of Guam, congratulate and commend the many engineers, architects, land

surveyors, landscape architects, the management and dedicated staff of the PEALS Board 1 and the members of the PEALS Board on the fiftieth anniversary; and, be it further 2 3 RESOLVED, that the Speaker, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the 4 adoption hereof and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Ms. Liza Provido, 5 Chairperson of the PEALS Board; to Ms. Amor Pakingan, Executive Board Administrator; Congresswoman Madeline Bordallo, Guam Delegate to U.S. Congress; 6 and to the Honorable Felix P.
