RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING MR. NGUYEN THAO VAN FOR HIS CONSISTENT COMMITMENT TO SERVING THE COMMUNITY, AND TO EXPRESSING SINCERE GRATITUDE FOR HIS YEARS OF KINDNESS AND GOOD WORK TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM.

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van was born to Nguyen Hai Van and
4 Nguyen Thi Danh in Saigon, Vietnam on November 21, 1950; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van is married to Mach Tuyetyuan-Thi,
6 and they are the proud parents of their son, Nguyen Tuan Van; and

7 **WHEREAS** Mr. Nguyen Thao Van moved to Guam in 1991, where he
8 began his local career in culinary services as a chef at Lien's Restaurant; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van opened Xuan's Restaurant, a
10 popular restaurant specializing in Vietnamese and Chinese cuisine, in Dededo
11 in 1993; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van became a naturalized citizen of the
2 United States of America in November 2000 and embraces Guam as his home
3 and the people of Guam as his extended family; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van is affectionately known by his local
5 friends and customers as “Wind Thao”; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van is a long-standing member of his
7 local parish, the Santa Barbara Catholic Church; and

8 **WHEREAS**, kindness and good work are the embodiment of public
9 spiritedness and moral character; and

10 **WHEREAS**, service to the community includes consistent small acts of
11 kindness and generosity to others; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van contributes consistently to charitable
13 causes, from fundraising for medical treatment, to youth activities, and has
14 given back to the community; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van has often utilized his culinary
16 abilities to serve the less fortunate, senior citizens and his local community
17 church, the Santa Barbara Catholic Church in Dededo; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Nguyen Thao Van frequently demonstrates his public-
19 spiritedness to family, friends, customers and members of the community
20 around him; now, therefore, be it

21 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trenta Na*
22 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the

1 people of Guam, congratulate and commend Mr. Nguyen Thao Van for his
2 consistent commitment to serving the community, and does express its sincere
3 gratitude for his years of kindness and good work to the people of Guam; and
