

7 **December 31, 1932; and**

8 **WHEREAS, Ben Arceo and Susie Reyes were classmates in 4<sup>th</sup> Grade at**  
9 **Chalan Pago Elementary School and became sweethearts after their Junior**  
10 **Prom at George Washington High School; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, Vicente “Ben” Gogue Arceo and Jesusa “Susie” Baza Reyes  
2 were united in the Holy Bonds of Matrimony on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of September,  
3 1950 at San Juan Bautista Catholic Church in Ordot, Guam, with their friends  
4 and family present; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Ben Arceo served honorably in the United States Army  
6 during the Korean War; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Ben and Susie Arceo are the proud father and mother,  
8 respectively, of Vincent R. Arceo, Millie A. Indalecio, Andrew J. “Joseph”  
9 Arceo, Frank R. “Frankie” Arceo, Terry A. Rodriguez, Frances A. Toves,  
10 Juanita R. Arceo, Diana R. Arceo, Susan A. Olivares, David R. Arceo, and Paul  
11 R. Arceo; and

12           **WHEREAS**, Ben and Susie Arceo have been blessed with thirty-three  
13 (33) grandchildren and ten (10) great grandchildren; and

14           **WHEREAS**, Ben and Susie Arceo are lifelong faithful Catholics and had  
15 served for twenty (20) years in the Parish Choir of St. Victor’s Church in San  
16 Jose, California, participate in the San Juan Bautista Catholic Church Choir

6 D.C. and have served as sources for University of Guam research into Guam's  
7 history and the Chamorro culture; and

9 contributions in support of the Chamorro culture through the Visual and  
10 Performing Arts; now, therefore, be it
