1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINTA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Lions Clubs International is one of the world's largest
4 community service organizations with over a million members representing more
5 than forty-six thousand (46,000) clubs in two hundred six (206) different countries
6 and regions. With the motto of "We Serve", members of the Lions Clubs help to
7 meet the growing needs of the communities they serve in through programs that
8 help the blind, empower the youth, care for the environment and help
9 disadvantaged communities; and

10 **WHEREAS,** District 204 of the International Association of Lions Clubs
11 consists of twenty (20) different Lions Clubs, fifteen (15) of which are located on
12 Guam, three (3) in Saipan, and one (1) each in Phonpei and the Marshall Islands.
13 These various clubs help to promote the vision of Lions Clubs International in
14 being the global leader in community and humanitarian service; and

15 **WHEREAS,** District 204 has adopted various charitable and community
16 service projects that have benefited the people of Guam and surrounding islands.

1 This includes, but is not limited to, recycling and beautification projects at Paseo,
2 Dededo, Tamuning, Mongmong-Toto-Maite and also in Saipan; community
3 service projects such as feeding the homeless at Kamalen Karidat, assisting in the
4 completion of houses for Habitat for Humanity, helping in the Salvation Army's
5 annual Christmas bell ringing and visiting the sick and elderly at Guam Memorial
6 Hospital and St. Dominic's; and also participating and helping to organize events
7 such as the Annual Leo Youth Camp, Island-wide Diabetes Awareness campaign,
8 Relay for Life and various sight and hearing conservation programs; and

9 **WHEREAS**, during Lion Year 2010-2011, the various Lions Clubs under
10 District 204 will continue their mission to empower their members to serve their
11 communities by providing projects that benefit our island's most disadvantaged
12 populations as well as projects that benefit the environment; and

14 exemplary leaders who will ensure the dedication of their members towards
15 specified goals and timeframes; and
