RELATIVE TO EXPRESSING THE 30TH GUAM LEGISLATURE'S CONGRATULATIONS, IN RECOGNITION OF THE LATTE TREATMENT CENTER RECEIVING AN AWARD OF FULL ACCREDITATION BY THE JOINT COMMISSION.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN 2 GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, the Lattee Treatment Center has been providing 4 residential group home services for adolescents and adults with cognitive 5 disabilities since June 2005 and March 2008, respectively, on behalf of the 6 Department of Mental Health & Substance Abuse and the Department of 7 Integrated Services for Individuals for Persons with Disabilities; and

8 WHEREAS, after a successful five year concerted effort, the Latte 9 Treatment Center has been awarded full accreditation by The Joint 10 Commission for a three year term; and

WHEREAS, after being weighed against a set of national standardsby a Joint Commission Surveyor experienced in the delivery of behavioral

health care services, the Joint Commission has now recognized the
 technical expertise of the staff and quality of the services provided by the
 Latte Treatment Center; and

WHEREAS, as a service provider that meets national standards, the
services provided facilitates the Department of Mental Health & Substance
Abuse compliance relative to the permanent injunction ordered pursuant
to U.S. District Court Civil Case CIV 01-00041; and

8 WHEREAS, the services provided have significantly minimized the 9 number of off-island referrals for treatment as well as reducing the average 10 treatment time from two to three years off-island, to one year with on-11 island treatment, which keeps families united and allows for the training of 12 parents and family members; and

WHEREAS, the people of Guam are benefiting from a significant
improvement in the quality of behavioral health care services on Guam,
they are as well realizing a major financial savings; and

WHEREAS, the Latte Treatment Center also serves as a practicum site for University of Guam graduate and under-graduate students studying clinical psychology, social work and counseling, and raising thereby the number and technical competence of health care professionals on Guam; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby on behalf of the people of Guam, congratulate the management and staff of the Latte Treatment Center in
