

- 6 Secretary in April 5, 1959 until the 7th Guam Legislature; and

- 10 Legislature as the Recording Secretary in January 3, 1967; and

- 13 Clerk, Office Administrator, Recording Secretary, Section Supervisor,
- 14 Legal Officer, Recording Secretary Supervisor from 11th Guam Legislature

Relative to recognizing the unprecedented dedication and superior performance of the Recording Secretary of the Twenty-Third Guam Legislature, and to authorizing a meritorious bonus therefor.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF THE TWENTY-THIRD GUAM LEGISLATURE:

WHEREAS, Mrs. Jane Lizama, the Recording Secretary and Supervisor of the Legal Office, Twenty-Third Guam Legislature, has demonstrated excellent performance in her duties, and, being senior in service than any other staff member or any of the incumbent senators, has earned the respect and admiration of all in the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Lizama's record of experience, loyalty, and dedication is one beyond comparison, having rendered a total of thirty-four (34) years of government service, beginning as an employee with the Fourth Guam Legislature and through the current Legislature, except during the Eighth Guam Legislature where she worked at the Governor's Office, and six (6) additional years as a contractual employee, while serving as an Attaché with

the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the untiring efforts of Mrs. Lizama and her extensive personal knowledge of the workings of the Legislature, especially the day-to-day operations of the Legal Office, have assured her invaluable contribution to the Legislature and resulted in her continued employment with the Legislature, having maintained the confidence of the senators to the extent that she held the position of Minority Staff Administrator when the Democrats were not the majority Party; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Committee on Rules that the unparalleled record of Mrs. Lizama, employed by this branch of government since the Fourth Guam Legislature, should not go unrecognized, and that she is most deserving of a meritorious bonus, long overdue, as a tribute to her superior performance; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that notwithstanding any other provisions of rules, regulations, or administrative practices, the Committee on Rules of the Twenty-Third Guam Legislature does hereby recognize the superior performance and long service of Mrs. Lizama, and does authorize her a meritorious bonus in an amount equal to three (3) months of regular compensation; and be it further
