


I MINA' TRENTA NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2010 (SECOND) REGULAR SESSION

WHEREAS, Chief Martinez embarked on his military career by
enlisting as a traditional guardsman in the Guam Air National Guard
on July 1982 as an Engineering Assistance Trainee with the 254th Civil

WHEREAS, upon completion of his Bachelors of Arts Degree in
Psychology and Education from the University of Guam in 1984, he
subsequently retrained into the Training career field as the Unit
Training Manager in 1986; and

WHEREAS, Chief Martinez took an active duty position for a period of four years in July of 1989 as the Base Training Manager for the 254th Air Base Group; and

Unit Award, the National Defense Service medal, the Armed Forces

Reserve Medal, the Air Force Longevity Service Award Ribbon with 1
