WHEREAS, Captain Santos is married to the former Glenda Calvo 6 of Rota and they have two beautiful children, Devin and Dane, and they 7 reside in Yigo; and 8

9 WHEREAS, Captain Santos joined the Guam Army National Guard on September 1998 and he has proudly served in the military for more 10 than eleven years; and 11

WHEREAS, Captain Santos is a graduate of the University of Guam 12 and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant through the Army Reserve 13 Officer Training Corps (ROTC) program in December 2000; and 14

WHEREAS, Captain Santos has received a number of awards and 14 commendations including: General George C. Marshall Award, Bronze 15 (1st Oak Leaf Cluster), Meritorious Service Medal, Army Star 16 Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, National Defense 17 Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Global War on 18 Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal (2 stars), 19 Armed Forces Reserve Medal (w/M device, numeral 3), Army Service 20 Ribbon, Overseas Training Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon (numeral 3), 21 NATO Medal, Combat Infantryman Badge, Airborne Badge, Air Assault 22 Badge, Ranger Tab, and the Colonel Ralph Pucket Award as a 23 Distinguished Honor Graduate; and 24
