16 Cabinet Maker; and

17          **WHEREAS**, Mr. Roldan retired from AAFB on August 31, 1989, with  
18 twenty (20) years of dedicated service; and

19          **WHEREAS**, the Roldan family name is firmly established in NCS,  
20 (*Gugagon Village*) *Dededo*, and spans four (4) generations; and

18   his Ninety-fifth (95<sup>th</sup>) Birthday Celebration; and be it further


19           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on


