Resolution No. 54-31 (COR)

Introduced by:

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Relative to recognizing and acknowledging those affected by autism, and their families, for their sacrifice and dedication to bettering the lives of children on Guam; and to further commending the Autism Community Together (ACT) for its efforts in promoting autism awareness, and on the observance of the month of April 2011 as "Autism Awareness Month".

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I

## 2 MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

- 3 WHEREAS, autism is a complex developmental disability that typically
- 4 appears during the first three (3) years of a person's life, and affects that person's

ability to communicate and interact with others; and

WHEREAS, autism is defined by a certain set of behaviors, and is a "Spectrum

3 Disorder" that affects individuals differently and to varying degrees; and

WHEREAS, autism is four (4) times more prevalent in boys than girls, and knows no racial, ethnic, or social boundaries; and

WHEREAS, there is no known single cause for autism, but increased awareness and funding can help families today; and

WHEREAS, in December 2009, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention issued its autism prevalence report, and concluded that the prevalence of autism had risen to one (1) in every one hundred ten (110) births in the United States, and to almost one (1) in seventy (70) boys; and

WHEREAS, thirteen million (13,000,000) American families are now living with the effects of Autism Spectrum Disorder, and the Autism Society currently estimates that the lifetime cost of caring for a child with autism ranges from Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) to Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000); and

WHEREAS, the United States faces almost \$90 Billion Dollars annually in costs for autism; and together with appropriate education and intervention, are vital to the future growth and development of individuals with autism; and

WHEREAS, through the increased awareness, and the services available to individuals with autism, the lives of our friends with autism can be made easier, while those without autism can expand their understanding of the needs and challenges that individuals with autism are experiencing; and

WHEREAS, parents, support groups, researchers, and professionals have dedicated years of service in their ongoing efforts to advocate for the rights, humane treatment, and appropriate education of all persons with autism, and in order to

1 highlight the growing need for concern and awareness about autism, the Autism

2 Society has been celebrating "National Autism Awareness Month" since the 1970s in

the United States, recognizing the month of April as a time of special opportunity to

educate the public about autism and issues within the autism community; and

WHEREAS, a Governor's Proclamation will be signed declaring April 2011 as *Autism Awareness Month*, when every resident of Guam is invited to participate in activities that educate and promote awareness of Autism Spectrum Disorders that affect members of our community, and their families; and

WHEREAS, Autism Community Together (ACT), formed in January 2004, is spearheading an awareness effort in order to educate parents, professionals and the general public about autism and its effects, and various activities are being coordinated throughout the month of April 2011 to further these goals, including a family day of bowling at Central Lanes in *Tamuning*; a display and fair at the *Agana* Shopping Center (ASC); a trolley ride from *Agana* Shopping Center in *Hagåtña* to the Micronesia Mall in *Dededo*, to include a luncheon at the ASC food court, and a family potluck at the Northern Region Pool Complex in *Dededo*; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, commend and acknowledge those affected by autism, and their families, for their sacrifice and dedication to bettering the lives of their children and others living with autism; and does further recognize Autism Community Together (ACT) for its efforts in promoting Autism awareness, and on the observance of the month of April 2011 as "Autism Awareness Month"; and be it further
