3 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Community College (GCC) is holding its 2nd Annual
4 “Distinguished Alumni” Award Ceremony on Wednesday, April 27, 2011; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Guam Community College is a key component of Guam’s
6 workforce development in the training and education of our future workforce; and

7 **WHEREAS**, GCC wishes to recognize those Alumni who have helped to build
8 on the mission of the College; who have contributed significantly to the military
9 buildup; who have achieved recognition on the national level; or who have dedicated
10 selflessly to improving the community, by selecting that person as the recipient of
11 GCC’s 2011 “Distinguished Alumni” Award, and for inclusion in the GCC “Walk of
12 Fame”; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez is a product of our own Trades Academy, and she
14 started her first business on Guam when she was nineteen (19) years old, and since
15 then she has been contributing to our island community through small business
16 development, education and service; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez has achieved a doctorate in Business Management,
18 and also earned several post-graduate degrees from prestigious universities, including
19 the University of Maryland and Harvard University; and

20 **WHEREAS**, her commitment to the development of our business community
21 through the education of our young people has been extensively demonstrated through
22 her service at the University of Guam; and

23 **WHEREAS**, in her pursuit of that aim, Dr. Enriquez was instrumental in
24 establishing the University of Guam Pacific Center for Economic Initiatives in 2006;

1 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez has secured several grants to help build our
2 community capacity, and to develop the Guam Veterans Association and the Guam
3 Procurement Technical Assistance Center; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez is currently serving our University of Guam as the
5 Dean of the School of Business and Public Administration, where she also oversees
6 the Guam Small Business Development Center; and


7 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Enriquez also currently serves our community as a member of

14 small business environment of Guam today; now, therefore, be it


15 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
