**Relative to recognizing and honoring Mrs. Preciosa Reyes Ulloa as she celebrates the one hundred first (101<sup>st</sup>) year of her life; to commending her for her many accomplishments and invaluable contributions to the people of Guam; and to further congratulating her as a “2011 Senior Citizens’ Month Centenarian”.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS,** Preciosa Reyes Ulloa was born in the village of *Talofof*o on  
4 October 24, 1910; and she is the daughter of †Maria Delos Reyes and †Vicente Ulloa;  
5 and

1           **WHEREAS**, being the eldest of six (6) children, Preciosa had many  
2 responsibilities growing up, and she naturally fell into the role as a caregiver, as well  
3 as being seen as a mother figure because she worked tirelessly to ensure that everyone  
4 in her family was fine by attending to their individual needs; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Preciosa married Felix Taitague and together they had two (2)  
6 children: †Josefa and David; and

7           **WHEREAS**, after the passing of her first husband at an early age, Preciosa  
8 married Mr. Vicente Castro in 1945, and together they had five (5) children: Joseph,  
9 †Frank, †Pedro, Arthur and Maria; and

10          **WHEREAS**, as a mother, Preciosa loved and provided for the physical and  
11 emotional needs of her children. Even as her children became adults, Preciosa always  
12 felt obligated to continue loving and caring for them; and

13          **WHEREAS**, despite Preciosa's second (2<sup>nd</sup>) marriage ending in a divorce in  
14 1977, she was a caregiver of her former husband on the weekends, when he was  
15 gravely ill with cancer, which demonstrated her caring and forgiving nature; and

16          **WHEREAS**, Ms. Ulloa had worked as a Housekeeper for the late Governor  
17 Carlos G. Camacho, and then later for his brother, Luis Camacho of Windward Hills;  
18 and

19          **WHEREAS**, Preciosa is described as very neat and organized, as evidenced by  
20 her choice of work, and she was never one to complain. She took it upon herself to  
21 ensure that things were done properly, and she worked hard and took pride in the  
22 quality of the work that she produced; and

23          **WHEREAS**, in 1994, while at work, Preciosa experienced a stroke and she had  
24 fallen down, injuring her head, and was quickly transported by ambulance to the  
25 emergency room. As a result of the stroke, Preciosa's independence was affected, and  
26 her activities were curtailed; and

1           **WHEREAS**, at that time, her medical doctor predicted that she possibly had six  
2 (6) months to live. Given the nature of Preciosa’s health, her family felt that it was in  
3 her best interest for Preciosa to receive the required care at the Saint Dominic’s Senior  
4 Care Home. To this day, almost seventeen (17) years later, Preciosa has lived beyond  
5 the life expectancy that her doctor predicted, and her family is looking forward to  
6 celebrating her One Hundred First (101<sup>st</sup>) Birthday on October 24, 2011; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Preciosa’s longevity was attributed to her taking good care of  
8 herself, and her daily walks to Church for prayers before the 7:00 a.m. Mass in  
9 *Talofof*; and

10          **WHEREAS**, Preciosa’s devotion to her faith and her dedication to her family is  
11 evident today, as she is blessed with twenty-seven (27) grandchildren, forty (40) great-  
12 grandchildren, eighteen (18) great-great grandchildren, and two (2) great-great-great  
13 grandchildren; and

14          **WHEREAS**, people who have known Preciosa would describe her as a very  
15 simple, patient, graceful, devoted, and quiet woman who dedicated her life to her  
16 faith, her family, and her work; now, therefore, be it

17          **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’ Trentai Unu Na*  
18 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of  
19 Guam, recognize and honor Ms. Preciosa Reyes Ulloa as she celebrates the one  
20 hundred first (101<sup>st</sup>) year of her life; does commend her for her many  
21 accomplishments and invaluable contributions to the people of Guam; and does  
22 further congratulate her as a “2011 Senior Citizens’ Month Centenarian”, and for her  
23 dedication to her faith and her family; and be it further

24          **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
