1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I* 2 *MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:*

3 WHEREAS, the Guam Homeless Coalition was created with the mission to 4 stay committed to the provision of housing and supportive services for individuals and 5 families who become homeless; and 1 WHEREAS, the Guam Homeless Coalition believes and recognizes that 2 quality housing should be tailored to meet the needs of the homeless individual and 3 families; and

4 WHEREAS, the vision of the Guam Homeless Coalition is to ensure that 5 homeless individuals and families regain housing stability through the expansion and 6 implementation of a comprehensive community-based housing delivery system to 7 prevent and to end homelessness; and

8 WHEREAS, the organization carries out this vision by: coordinating and/or 9 integrating homeless-related programs for smooth transition throughout our 10 continuum of care system; implementing an effective and efficient delivery system of services to prevent homelessness and to move homeless families into permanent 11 12 housing; developing an accessible and comprehensive system which receives individuals and families in need of care and moves them through a system toward 13 14 independent living and sustainability; and developing strong homeless programs and 15 services with sustainable links; and

WHEREAS, to address the growing demand for homeless services, the Guam
Homeless Coalition, through its lead agency, the Guam Housing & Urban Renewal
Authority (GHURA), searched for and applied for funding; and

WHEREAS, in December 2000, Guam became the first U.S. Territory to
receive Continuum of Care funds for the homeless from the U.S. Department of
Housing and Urban Development, to implement new shelter programs for the
homeless; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Homeless Coalition is comprised of government agencies, non-profit organizations, and the private sector, that come together for the purpose of responding to the needs of homeless youth, families, and single adults; and WHEREAS, Guam Homeless Coalition members include the organizations
 that operate shelters for homeless youth, families and single adults, and mainstream
 agencies that provide supportive services; and

4 WHEREAS, with the help of these members, the Guam Homeless Coalition 5 has been able to make a significant positive impact on the island community by 6 addressing the issue of homelessness; and

7 WHEREAS, the Guam Homeless Coalition conducts various activities and
8 sponsors programs to help combat homelessness; and

9 WHEREAS, the Guam Homeless Coalition takes the lead role in the annual 10 homeless count around the island to collect data that is used by homeless service 11 providers, the community, and policymakers in developing programs and facilities to 12 assist and benefit our homeless population; now therefore, be it

13 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na* 14 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*, does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the 15 people of Guam, extend a sincere *Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to the Guam 16 Homeless Coalition and all its members, for their hard work and dedication to ensure 17 that the homelessness among the island is ended; and be it further

18 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules 19 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of 20 the same be thereafter transmitted to the Guam Homeless Coalition; and to the 21 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
