- 6 on September 25, 2004; and

1 WHEREAS, Consul General Tate, who hails from Naga City, is married to Issa 2 De La Cruz, also from Naga City, and they have a son, Julian Rasheed; and 3 WHEREAS, in 1986. Consul General Tate attended Naga Parochial School, where he received his elementary education; and then attended high school at the Holy 4 5 Rosary Minor Seminary, where he graduated in 1990; and 6 WHEREAS, Consul General Tate is an AB English (Literature) 1995 graduate of the Ateneo de Naga University, where consistently made the Dean's List. He then 7 8 studied law at the University of the Philippines, from 1995 to 1998; and he earned his 9 Bachelor of Laws from the Far Eastern University in 2002; and 10 WHEREAS, Consul General Tate is a Career Officer in the Department of 11 Foreign Affairs (DFA), with the rank of Foreign Service Officer (FSO) I. He joined 12 the DFA in 2000 after passing the highly competitive Foreign Service Officers 13 examination in 1999; and WHEREAS, from 2001 to 2002, Consul General Tate served as the Acting 14 Director of the Property, Engineering and Transportation Division of the Office of 15 16 Personnel and Administrative Services; and 17 WHEREAS, Consul General Tate had also served as Principal Assistant at the 18 Office of Asian and Pacific Affairs' Southeast Asia Division, from 2002 to 2003; and 19 at the Office of American Affairs in 2002; and 20 WHEREAS, prior to being appointed to his post here on Guam, Consul General Tate was the Acting Director of the Authentication Division of the DFA's 21 22 Office of Consular Affairs, from 2003 to 2004; and 23 WHEREAS, Consul General Tate is also a member of *Kabulig*, the Bicolano 24 writers' group of the Philippine National Center for Culture and the Arts; he was the 25 Editor-in-Chief of the Pillars, the Ateneo De Naga University newspaper; and was the Captain of the Ateneo University Debate Team; and 26
