 from Japan visited Guam for the purpose of showing respect and extending prayers for
 those who died on Guam during World War II; and

4 WHEREAS, the students visited the War in the Pacific National Park, Gaan 5 Point, the *Faha* Massacre site, and the *Manenggon* Memorial Park in order to better 6 understand the horrors of war and its effects on both the innocent civilians caught in its 7 wake, and the soldiers who fought it; and

8 WHEREAS, it is hoped that this will continue to be an annual trip, and that the 9 tributes paid by these high school students will shine as an example that will encourage 10 other students and organizations from Japan to make similar trips; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Explore and Study, Inc, has been instrumental in trying to heal the wounds of World War II, and the tensions over the war between the people of Guam, Japan and the United States, and it has held ceremonies and tributes in the past years with that noble aim; and

WHEREAS, the *U.S. Explore and Study, Inc.*, along with its President, Mr. Kensuke Haga, have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals, and especially to help organize this trip by Japanese high school students; now therefore, be it
