1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN***
2 ***GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS,** the MagPRO Awards is a government-wide employee
4 recognition program within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam. It
5 is the highest and most competitive employee awards program bestowed by *I*
6 *Maga'lahaen Guåhan* (the Governor of Guam), which showcases the outstanding
7 employees and programs of the government of Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the recognition and competition spans over forty (40)
2 departments and agencies, and fifty-five (55) occupational groups ranging from
3 clerical, labor, trades, professional and technical positions. The various awards
4 reflect individual and group performance, valor, cost savings, integrity,
5 community service and sports; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the MagPRO Awards Program is an expanded version of the
7 Magnificent Seven Program, a government-wide awards recognition which began
8 in 1987. The general concept of the Magnificent Seven Program, commonly
9 referred to as "*Mag7*," has continued throughout the years; and

10 **WHEREAS**, most departments and agencies have adopted the *Mag7*
11 program, and have tailored it to fit their own organizational needs; and

12 **WHEREAS**, previous Governors have added other award categories to the
13 *Mag7*, and have implemented the program at a government-wide level under the
14 titles of the "*Excel Program*" and the "*MagHOPE Program*"; and

15 **WHEREAS**, public service is a noble calling involving a variety of
16 challenging and rewarding professions, while at the same time providing an
17 opportunity to recognize and promote the important contributions of public
18 servants and honor the diverse men and women who meet the needs of Guam
