1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN***
2 ***GUÁHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS, on February 20, 1972, the Hilton Guam Resort & Spa (HGRS)**
4 **opened for business, and was the first international hotel built on Guam; and since**
5 **then it has served Guam's fast evolving tourism market, catering to guests from Japan,**
6 **Korea, China, the Philippines, Russia, the United States of America, and from many**
7 **other destinations; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, the Hilton Guam Resort & Spa is located on *Tumon Bay*, sitting
2 on thirty-two (32) acres of prime beachfront property with a magnificent view of
3 *Tumon Bay* and Two Lover’s Point; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Hilton has expanded its facilities throughout the years, and
5 now includes six hundred forty-five (645) rooms in the Main Tower, the Premier
6 Tower, and the Tasi Club; the Arluis Chapel and the St. Probus Holy Chapel; the
7 finest competitive tennis courts on Guam; five (5) swimming pools; and six (6) food
8 and beverage outlets; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Hilton promotes the *Chamorro* culture through its unique
10 private collection of local art pieces, and incorporates the “*Hafa Adai Spirit*” in its
11 everyday business practices; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the Hilton is proud to be one of the largest employers on Guam,
13 providing exceptional work experiences for its valued associates, and training the
14 leaders of tomorrow; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Hilton is the site of more than one thousand (1,000) weddings
16 per year, creating lasting and romantic memories for couples and families; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Hilton manages six (6) of the most popular restaurants on
18 Guam, including the legendary Roy’s Restaurant, the sensational Tropics BBQ, and
19 the award-winning Fisherman’s Cove; and

20 **WHEREAS**, in 2007, the Hilton Guam Resort & Spa was purchased by PHR
21 KEN Corporation. Through their investment in the Hilton, as well as other hotels and
22 attractions, PHR KEN is helping make Guam a world-class tourist destination; and

23 **WHEREAS**, in 2009, the Hilton Guam Resort & Spa opened its six thousand
24 (6,000) square feet Wellness Center, which features Precor fitness machines, free
25 weights, men’s and women’s locker rooms, each with saunas, and golf training
26 equipment, among other features; and

1 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
2 the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Nicolaus
3 Priesniz, General Manager, Hilton Guam Resort & Spa; and to the Honorable Edward
4 J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
