4           **WHEREAS**, after six (6) years, Jack Yoshino began his real estate career with  
5 partners in the United States, and made real estate investments in hotels, offices and  
6 housing, while living in Los Angeles and New York; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Jack Yoshino joined Ken Corporation in 2002; and he was  
8 appointed as President of P.H.R. Ken Asset Management Inc. in November 2006; and

9           **WHEREAS**, after joining Ken Corporation, Mr. Yoshino improved his  
10 acquaintance in the acquisition of real estate properties and asset management, and he  
11 was assigned to work in Guam, where he has been managing hotels and upgrading the  
12 image of Guam as a tourist destination for over five (5) years; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Yoshino’s other responsibilities included oversight of the  
14 Hilton Guam Resort & Spa, the Hyatt Regency Guam, the Hotel Nikko Guam, the  
15 Pacific Islands Club Guam, the Sheraton Laguna Guam Resort, the Country Club of  
16 the Pacific in Guam, and the Aqua Resort Club in Saipan; and


17           **WHEREAS**, Jack Yoshino has been an active member of the Board of

2 further


3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to,
