2 working as a Manpower Development Trainee with the Guam Department of Labor;

4 **WHEREAS**, in October 1979, Annie transferred to the Department of
5 Administration, Division of Accounts, where she worked as a Clerk II; and

6 **WHEREAS**, throughout Annie's career at the Department of Administration,
7 she had steadily progressed; and she will retire from her position as an Accounting
8 Technician III; and

9 **WHEREAS**, while serving at the Department of Administration, Annie had
10 assisted in developing the reconciliation framework between the Department of
11 Administration and the Customs and Quarantine Agency; as well as assisting with
12 travel payments and advances; cost of living allowances and supplemental annuity
13 retiree payments; collections from autonomous agencies; and fuel and supplies
14 billings and collections; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Annie has left a lasting legacy amongst her professional
16 colleagues, friends and family that will continue, even as she proudly retires from a
17 wonderful career at the Department of Administration; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Annie has also dedicated much of her spare time serving as a
19 dedicated, active and devout Catholic and parishioner of the Santa Teresita Church in
20 *Mangilao*, where she has been assisting with the preparation of the celebration of
21 Mass; the organization of the Parish activities; the cleaning of the *Santa Teresita*
22 Church; and she assists with praying the Rosary to the Blessed Mother throughout the
23 community. Annie has been a member of the Legion of Mary for over fifteen (15)
24 years, and she has devoted countless hours visiting and praying for the sick at the
25 Skilled Nursing Unit, at the St. Dominic's Senior Care Home, and for the inmates at

1 the Department of Corrections; and she has been a member of the Confraternity of
2 Christian Mothers of the Archdiocese of *Agaña*; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Annie has selflessly dedicated many years of her life in public
4 service for Guam and her people; now therefore, be it


5 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*

16 Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.


