1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

8 structure under the direction of a steering committee; and

9           **WHEREAS**, the Guam Young Professionals, as an initiative of the Guam  
10 Chamber of Commerce, strives to provide young, driven professionals with  
11 the opportunity to connect with each other throughout the island, and to serve  
12 as their voice; and

13           **WHEREAS**, the Guam Young Professionals also provides the  
14 opportunity to network and foster relationships with its members, employers  
15 and other special interest groups to promote maximum participation, to meet  
16 and interact with prominent business and philanthropic leaders, to develop  
17 professional skills and find career placement/advancement opportunities to  
18 service the community, and to gain leadership experience through committee


