7 the Chonsan University in China; and he has extensive experience in the
8 construction industry, after working his way up through the ranks at
9 Dillingham Construction in the 1970s; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Young started working with Hawaiian Rock Products
11 thirty (30) years ago; he was the Chief Engineer at Hawaiian Rock Products
12 for five (5) years, after which he served as the Vice President of Operations,
13 and he then became the Executive Vice President of the Company; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Young, as Executive Vice President of Hawaiian Rock
15 Products, had overall management and charge of numerous Government of
16 Guam projects, as well as Air Force, Navy and privately-owned projects; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Young is a former President of the Guam Chinese
18 Association, and he still serves as an active member of the Association; and


19 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Young has been an outstanding businessman and

3 Special Olympics and the Shriners; now, therefore, be it


4 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na*

14 the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.


