1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**

3        **WHEREAS,** the Lodging Management Program (LMP) is a National  
4        Education Program for high school students that covers topics in the program,  
5        including but *not* limited to, lodging management; rooms division operations;

1 leadership skills; career planning; food and beverage skills; sales and marketing; and  
2 event planning; and

3 **WHEREAS**, an annual LMP competition is sponsored by the American Hotel  
4 and Lodging's Educational Institute that is meant to provide a venue to demonstrate,  
5 challenge, and expose students to the functions of the hotel industry; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in 2001, the Guam Community College established its Lodging  
7 Management Program and has established programs at each of Guam's public schools,  
8 hosting its own local competition to determine the Guam representative to the  
9 National LMP Competition held annually in Florida State; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the National Lodging Management Program Competition was  
11 held on April 7 to 9, 2011, at the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort in Orlando, Florida; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the Guam representative for 2011 was the LMP Team from  
13 *Okkodo* High School, under the tutelage of Assistant Professor Norman Aguilar, and  
14 comprised of members Raquel Maminta, Iris Lapid, Jessica De Vera and Donna Faye  
15 Lubas; and

16 **WHEREAS**, in all, twelve (12) state teams competed and the *Okkodo* High  
17 School LMP Team is the first group from Guam to place 1<sup>st</sup> for the 2011 National  
18 Lodging Management Competition, winning the LMP National Championship Title;
