2 Maris Bros High School in American Samoa, and he later attended the Guam  
3 Community College; and

4       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Aigamaua and his wife, Marina, are the proud parents of two  
5 (2) daughters, Deanna and Mariana; and two (2) sons, Alex and Andrew; and

6       **WHEREAS**, in addition to spending time with his family and friends, Dean  
7 enjoys playing golf and fishing; and

8       **WHEREAS**, Dean has been described by his colleagues as someone who is  
9 always willing to lend a helping hand to others, whether he is on or off duty; and

10       **WHEREAS**, Dean has been able to touch many lives through his service at the  
11 Guam Fire Department, and through his work in the Advance Life Support Unit and  
12 the Rescue Unit; and

13       **WHEREAS**, Mr. Aigamaua has always been very generous in sharing his  
14 knowledge and information about firefighting with his fellow firefighters; and

15       **WHEREAS**, in October 2011, Dean displayed exemplary courage, and  
16 commitment to his position as a firefighter and protector of the people of Guam, when  
17 he risked his life to pull a man from a burning vehicle at the intersection of Route 1  
18 and Route 3 in *Dededo*, while he was off-duty; and


19       **WHEREAS**, Fire Lieutenant Dean Aigamaua was selected as the “Emergency

26 the “EMT-Basic of the Year” for the 2012 EMS Star of Life Week; and does further


1 extend a sincere *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase'* to him for his service and

6 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.


