3        **WHEREAS,** the Bolinao-Bani Association of Guam (BBAG) was organized in  
4        1989, and was made possible through the efforts of Gil Caasi, Tommy Cabanayan,  
5        †Elias Calicdan, Van Carranza, Pastor Celeste, Lenor Fernandez, Virgilio Leones,

1 Rolando Odero, †Diosdado Caasi, and †Amor Capucao, Sr., and their families, in the  
2 spirit of brotherhood, unity, social acquaintance, and mutual aid among the Bolinao  
3 and Bani residents of Guam; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Bolinao-Bani Association of Guam is a non-profit civic  
5 organization whose main objective is for the general membership to contribute to the  
6 economic growth of the towns of Bolinao and Bani, Pangasinan, Philippines, and the  
7 island of Guam by helping local charitable institutions, such as the American Red  
8 Cross, the American Cancer Society, and Catholic Social Service; and assisting in  
9 community projects; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the Association has been able to foster goodwill and friendship  
11 among its members, while accomplishing their various goals through members'  
12 interest and participation. The sacrifices, hard work, support and cooperation from  
13 each member of the Bolinao-Bani Association of Guam has greatly contributed to the  
14 success of all the Association's activities; and

15 **WHEREAS**, BBAG has also made generous contributions to the Salvation  
16 Army, the Guam Lytico & Bodig, the Sugar Plum Tree, People Helping People, the  
17 South Pacific Games, St. Dominic's Senior Care Home, the Pangasinan Community  
18 of Guam, and the Filipino Community of Guam; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Association has coordinated with the Department of Parks and  
20 Recreation and the Pangasinan Community of Guam, Incorporated to adopt *Liguan*  
21 Terrace Park No. 2 in *Dededo* since 1993, through the Adopt-A-Park Program. BBAG  
22 has taken part in the upkeep of the Park by cleaning, planting, making repairs and  
23 maintaining the adjacent bus stop as part of the beautification project, along with the  
24 *Guåhan* Lions Club; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the Bolinao-Bani Association of Guam remains one of the most  
26 visible Filipino organizations on Guam whose accomplishments are attributed to the

1 commitment and effective coordination of its officers; and above all, to the increasing  
2 number of loyal members who provide their dedicated service to carry out their role in  
3 the community; and

4 **WHEREAS**, BBAG continues to promote civic awareness among its members  
5 through activities that help develop the community, such as continued park  
6 improvement and fundraising efforts for charitable projects, and also hopes to  
7 continue to promote and enhance the importance of unity among all families from  
8 Bani, Bolinao, and all the neighboring towns; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Bolinao-Bani Association of Guam will continue to carry out  
10 their mission through the leadership of their newly inducted Officers and Board of  
11 Directors to include: Nick Caasi, President; Juliet Barroga, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President; Flor  
12 Cacapit, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President; Belinda Villareal, Secretary; Percy De Vera, Assistant  
13 Secretary; Eva Ramolete, Treasurer; Leilani Celeste, Assistant Treasurer; Genie  
14 Pascual, Auditor; Sabina Aguilo, Business Manager; Cel Ramolete, Public Relations  
15 Officer; Remelito Pascua, Sergeant at Arms; and Perfecto Ubongen, Sergeant at  
16 Arms; now therefore, be it

23 it further


24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
