Relative to recognizing and commending Japan-based All Nippon Airways (ANA) for celebrating their twenty-fifth (25th) anniversary of international service and for contributing significantly to the economic development and tourism industry in Guam.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

1 **WHEREAS**, All Nippon Airways (ANA) has planned three charter flights
2 via jumbo aircraft Boeing 747s to Guam in March 2011 in celebration of its 25th
3 anniversary of international service; and

4 **WHEREAS**, these 'sentimental flights', as their industry partners call them,
5 scheduled to depart Japan on the 3rd, 10th, and 18th of March, respectively, are
6 significant because they represent the growth of the tourism industry in Guam over
7 the last twenty five years; and

8 **WHEREAS**, these flights are also symbolic of the historical evolution of the
9 company, from the humble beginnings of a helicopter service, to a charter

10 passenger service, to a scheduled passenger service, to a start-up of cargo services
11 on the trunk line Tokyo-Osaka route, to a scheduled international service with the
12 opening of a Tokyo-Guam route twenty five years ago; and

13 **WHEREAS**, since that first All Nippon Airways flight departed from
14 Tokyo on March 3, 1986, visitor arrivals from Japan to Guam via All Nippon
15 Airways, along with their counterparts, Continental Airlines and Japan Airlines,
16 have grown exponentially; and

17 **WHEREAS**, ANA has reaped great success over the years, carrying a
18 cumulative total of 1 billion passengers on both domestic and international routes
19 by the year 2003, and continues to exceed this number with each scheduled flight;
20 and

21 **WHEREAS**, this success was built on a foundation of security and
22 reliability that All Nippon Airways creates attractive surroundings for customers,
23 continues to be a familiar presence, and offers dreams and experiences to people
24 around the world; and

25 **WHEREAS**, All Nippon Airways has committed to the idea and practice
26 that safety is their promise to the public and the foundation of their business, that
27 safety is assured by an integrated management system and mutual respect, and
28 that safety is enhanced through individual performance and education; and

29 **WHEREAS**, All Nippon Airways strives to be a company that continues
30 to work for environmental sustainability through proactive efforts for the sake of
31 people and the earth;

32 **WHEREAS**, ANA continues to tackle challenges in order to sensitively
33 respond to environmental changes and social needs, and fulfill their social
34 responsibilities; and

35 **WHEREAS**, ANA's environmental principles are guided by the
36 recognition of the burdensome impact of activities to the Earth, the need to
37 minimize the use of natural resources and energy, and the need to engage and
38 support the realization of a more affluent society; and

39 **WHEREAS**, to this end, All Nippon Airways is keeping abreast with
40 internal and external developments relevant to global environmental issues in
41 consistently implementing measures to combat global warming, including the
42 ANA Group Ecology Plan; and

43 **WHEREAS**; All Nippon Airways, undoubtedly exemplifies the meaning
44 of a great corporate system, because it is a corporate company that focuses on
45 financial aspects, but also strikes a good balance with society and the
46 environment; now, therefore, be it

47 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does
48 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend All Nippon
49 Airways for their committed service to Guam; and be it further

50 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest
51 to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to All
52 Nippon Airways and to the Honorable Edward B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
