RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING AND HONORING THE COURAGEOUS MEN AND WOMEN OF THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT, PORT POLICE, AIRPORT POLICE, AND FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS FOR THEIR SELFLESS SERVICE IN THE PROTECTION OF LIFE AND PROPERTY; AND EXTENDS A WARMHEARTED UN DANGKOLO' NA SI YU'OS MA'ASE' ON BEHALF OF THE PEOPLE OF GUAM FOR THE VALUABLE SERVICE TO THE ISLAND COMMUNITY; AND JOINS IN THE CELEBRATION OF "GUAM POLICE WEEK" DURING THE WEEK OF MAY 15-21, 2011.

BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI UNO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

1       WHEREAS, National Police Week will be celebrated nationwide from  
2 May 15-21, 2011, during which time Guam will join in the celebration, as a  
3 special tribute to the wonderful men and women of law enforcement who  
4 protect our nation's numerous communities, and on the local front, our island  
5 community; and

6       WHEREAS, the courageous uniformed personnel of the Guam Police  
7 Department, the Port Authority of Guam Police, the A. B. Won Pat

1 International Airport Authority Police, and the federal law enforcement  
2 officers enforce the laws of our island every day, placing their lives at risk to  
3 serve and to protect our citizens; and

4 **WHEREAS**, with the constant increase of crimes being committed by  
5 individuals in our community annually, our police officers and law  
6 enforcement personnel continue to serve, despite the demand to work above  
7 and beyond designated work hours, sacrificing regularly their personal and  
8 family time for the welfare and safety of the community; and

9 **WHEREAS**, these brave men and women work daily with civilian  
10 personnel who perform critical functions in support of uniformed police  
11 officers, of whose efforts must continue to be recognized for their contribution  
12 to public safety; and

13 **WHEREAS**, many of Guam's police, law enforcement personnel, and  
14 peace officers, have given the ultimate sacrifice of selflessness to the people of  
15 Guam and have died in the line of duty serving their island community; and

16 **WHEREAS**, all men and women in uniform, (active, retired or past  
17 limited service) who have served as a police officer, law enforcement official,  
18 or peace officer should be given special recognition and tribute for their  
19 individual and collective service to the people of Guam; and

20 **WHEREAS**, family members, i.e. parents, spouses, and children, of  
21 these police, law enforcement, and peace officers should also be recognized  
22 for their indirect service to the island of Guam in providing necessary support

1 and encouragement to these men and women in uniform who serve and  
2 protect; now, therefore, be it

3         **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Uno na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
4 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the men and  
5 women of the Guam Police Department, Port Authority of Guam Police, the  
6 A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Police , and the federal law  
7 enforcement officers for their dedication, courage, and professionalism in  
8 their tremendous service to the people of Guam during the special celebration  
9 of Guam Police Week on the week of May 15-21, 2011; and does hereby  
10 encourage the entire island community to join in the celebration, and to  
11 participate with all law enforcement uniformed and civilian members, in the  
12 numerous programs designed to encourage the adherence to law, to promote  
13 public safety, and to pay tribute to the brave police officers and peace officers  
14 of Guam and across the nation who have given so much to the preservation of  
15 life and property through the fair and efficient enforcement of law; and be it  
16 further

17         **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Uno na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
18 on behalf of the people of Guam, further extend a warmhearted Un Dangkolo'  
19 Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase' to all of the following: all the men and women who  
20 continue to serve or who have at one time served the community of Guam as  
21 a police, law enforcement, or peace officer; all the men and women who in the  
22 civilian community who provide direct or indirect support to these police  
23 officers; and to all the spouses, children, parents, and family members for

1 their selfless support to their family member as they serve and protect the  
2 people of Guam; and be it further

3 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify and the Secretary of the  
4 Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be  
5 thereafter transmitted to Mr. Fred Bordallo, Chief of Police, Guam Police  
6 Department; Ms. Doris Aguero, Chief, Port Authority of Guam Police; Mr.  
7 Robert Camacho, Chief, A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Police;  
8 administrators, federal law enforcement agencies, Guam; and to the  
9 Honorable Edward J. B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
