## BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI UNO NA LIHESLATURAN **GUĂHAN:**

- WHEREAS, National Police Week will be celebrated nationwide from 1

- WHEREAS, the courageous uniformed personnel of the Guam Police 6
- Department, the Port Authority of Guam Police, the A. B. Won Pat 7

1 International Airport Authority Police, and the federal law enforcement

2 officers enforce the laws of our island every day, placing their lives at risk to

serve and to protect our citizens; and

WHEREAS, with the constant increase of crimes being committed by individuals in our community annually, our police officers and law enforcement personnel continue to serve, despite the demand to work above and beyond designated work hours, sacrificing regularly their personal and family time for the welfare and safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, these brave men and women work daily with civilian personnel who perform critical functions in support of uniformed police officers, of whose efforts must continue to be recognized for their contribution to public safety; and

WHEREAS, many of Guam's police, law enforcement personnel, and peace officers, have given the ultimate sacrifice of selflessness to the people of Guam and have died in the line of duty serving their island community; and

WHEREAS, all men and women in uniform, (active, retired or past limited service) who have served as a police officer, law enforcement official, or peace officer should be given special recognition and tribute for their individual and collective service to the people of Guam; and

WHEREAS, family members, i.e. parents, spouses, and children, of these police, law enforcement, and peace officers should also be recognized for their indirect service to the island of Guam in providing necessary support and encouragement to these men and women in uniform who serve and protect; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that *I Mina'Trentai Uno na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the men and women of the Guam Police Department, Port Authority of Guam Police, the A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Police, and the federal law enforcement officers for their dedication, courage, and professionalism in their tremendous service to the people of Guam during the special celebration of Guam Police Week on the week of May 15-21, 2011; and does hereby encourage the entire island community to join in the celebration, and to participate with all law enforcement uniformed and civilian members, in the numerous programs designed to encourage the adherence to law, to promote public safety, and to pay tribute to the brave police officers and peace officers of Guam and across the nation who have given so much to the preservation of life and property through the fair and efficient enforcement of law; and be it further
