- WHEREAS, the nearly 3.1 million registered nurses in the United
- 2 States comprise our nation's largest health care profession; and
- WHEREAS, the depth and breadth of the registered nursing
- 4 profession meets the different and emerging health care needs of the
- 5 American, as well as, Guam's population in a wide range of settings; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the American Nurses Association, as the voice for the
- 7 registered nurses of this country and the Guam Nurses Association, as the
- 8 voice for the registered nurses of this island, is working to chart a new
- 9 course for a healthy nation and island that relies on increasing delivery of
- primary and preventive health care; and

11	WHEREAS, that more qualified registered nurses will be needed in
12	the future to meet the increasingly complex needs of health care consumers
13	in this community; and
14	WHEREAS, the cost-effective, safe and quality health care services
15	provided by registered nurses will be an ever more important component of
16	the U.S. health care delivery system in the future; and

18	Commission Accreditation of the Guam Memorial Hospital Agency and the
19	Health Services of the Pacific-Hospice; and
