THEIR FIRST (1st) PLACE OVERALL SHOWING AT
THE AMERICAN HOTEL & LODGING
EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTE NATIONAL LODGING
MANAGEMENT PROGRAM COMPETITION HELD
FROM APRIL 7 TO 9, 2011 IN ORLANDO, FLORIDA.**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF**

2 ***I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** the Lodging Management Program (LMP) is a National
4 Education Program for high school students that covers topics in the program,
5 including but not limited to, lodging management, rooms division operations,
6 leadership skills, career planning, food and beverage skills, sales and marketing,
7 and event planning; and

8 **WHEREAS,** an annual LMP competition is sponsored by the American
9 Hotel and Lodging's Educational Institute that is meant to provide a venue to

1 demonstrate, challenge, and expose students to the functions of the hotel industry;
2 and

3 **WHEREAS**, in 2001, the Guam Community College established its
4 Lodging Management Program and has established programs at each of Guam's
5 public schools, hosting its own local competition to determine the Guam
6 representative to the National LMP Competition held annually in Florida State; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Lodging Management Program National Competition was
8 held on April 7 to 9, 2011 at the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort in Orlando, Florida;
9 and

10 **WHEREAS**, the Guam representative for 2011 was the team from Okkodo
11 High School, under the tutelage of Assistant Professor Norman Aguilar, comprised
12 of members: Raquel Maminta, Iris Lapid, Jessica De Vera, Donna Faye Lubas; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in all, twelve (12) state teams competed and the Okkodo High
14 School team is the first group from Guam to place 1st for the 2011 National
15 Lodging Management Competition to win the LMP national championship title;
16 and now, therefore be it

17 **RESOLVED**, that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam,
18 recognize the Okkodo High School LMP team as the first team representing our
19 island to achieve the national championship title of the American Hotel & Lodging
20 Educational Institute National Lodging Management Program Competition; and be

23 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, commend and extend its
24 congratulations to the team and its instructor for their national championship and
