



DAVE SHOJI AND A SINCERE UN DANGKOLO NA SI YO'US MA'ASE FOR INSPIRING GUAM'S YOUNG ADULTS AS GUEST SPEAKER OF THE 10<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL SHIEH SU YING SCHOLAR ATHLETE OF THE YEAR AWARDS BANQUET AND RECOGNIZING HIS AMAZING ACCOMPLISHMENTS AS THE LEGENDARY UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL HEAD COACH**

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Dave Shoji has been the Head Coach of the University of  
5 Hawaii Rainbow Wahine Volleyball team since 1975; and

6 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Shoji played his collegiate career as a setter at the  
7 University of California, Santa Barbara, where he earned honors as a 2-time All-  
8 American in 1968 and 1969; and

1           **WHEREAS**, he is known as a coach whose teams possesses outstanding  
2 ball control, he has been honored with the title of All-Time Great Coach Award in  
3 the Donald S. Shondell Contemporary Division of USA Volleyball in 2002 and  
4 was also named Coach of the NCAA Division I 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Women's  
5 Volleyball team in 2005 and was inducted to the Hawaii Sports Hall of Fame in the  
6 same year; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Shoji was named the American Volleyball Coaches  
8 Association National Coach of the Year twice, once in 1982 and the second time in  
9 2009; and

10           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Shoji was named the AVCA West Region Coach of the  
11 Year Ten (10) times and the Western Athletic Conference Coach of the Year  
12 Eleven (11) times; and

13           **WHEREAS**, on December 16, 2010 Mr. Shoji was inducted into the  
14 AVCA Hall of Fame; and

15           **WHEREAS**, in 2010 the University of Hawaii Rainbow Wahine captured  
16 their 14<sup>th</sup> straight regular season Western Athletic Conference title, winning all of  
17 the conference matches by sweeps for the first time in the university's history; and

1           **WHEREAS**, during the season the UH Rainbow Wahine established school  
2 records with a 62-set win streak winning twenty-three (23) consecutive matches  
3 eventually advancing to its 29<sup>th</sup> consecutive NCAA tournament; and

4           **WHEREAS**, in 2009 Mr. Shoji became the second head coach in NCAA  
5 Division I women’s volleyball history to reach a 1,000-win milestone, currently  
6 ranking him second all-time in Division I. Dave Shoji is the longest tenured Coach  
7 in Women’s Volleyball and post an amazing record with the University of Hawaii  
8 Rainbow Wahine of 1,042 wins, 177 losses and 1 tie;

9           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Shoji has guided the Rainbow Wahine to 25 NCAA  
10 Regional appearances, and has totaled eighteen (18) 30-plus win seasons and  
11 coached the Wahine Rainbow’s to four (4) national Championships including an  
12 AIAW title in 1979 and three NCAA Division I crowns in 1982, ’83 and ’87; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Shoji has coached twenty-four (24) AVCA All-American  
14 athletes throughout his career as the Wahine Head Coach, some of which have  
15 represented the United States Volleyball team in the Olympics and others who  
16 became coaches at nationally accredited programs: now, therefore, be it:

17           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina ‘Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* (the 31<sup>st</sup>  
18 Guam Legislature) does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, extend a warm  
19 Hafa Adai and welcome to Guam to Mr. Dave Shoji and a sincere Un Dangkolo’

1 Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase for inspiring Guam's young adults as guest speaker of the 10<sup>th</sup>  
2 Annual Shieh Su Ying Scholar Athlete of the Year Awards Banquet and for  
3 recognizing his amazing accomplishments as the legendary University of Hawaii  
4 Women's Volleyball Head Coach; and, be it further

5 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Committee on Rules certify, and the  
6 Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be  
7 thereafter transmitted to Mr. Dave Shoji, legendary University of Hawaii Women's  
8 Volleyball Coach; to Dr. Thomas Shieh, Shieh Su Ying Scholar Athlete of the  
9 Year Founder; and to the Honorable Edward J. B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
