1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**

4 **WHEREAS**, during times of a weakened economy, when many of our
5 people face financial hardships, jobs are sparse and gas prices continue to escalate
6 at a record pace, a local family has stepped up to the entrepreneurial plate and
7 joined Guam's economic backbone: our small business sector, not only seizing a
8 business opportunity for themselves but creating opportunity and jobs for others;

10 **WHEREAS**, John A. Ananich, along with his brother Jose, have developed
11 Protective Armor Coatings of the Pacific, Inc. doing business as Armor Coatings
12 Micronesia, looking to become Guam's premiere residential and commercial
13 protective coating solutions company. In its short existence and even before its
14 Grand Opening, Armor Coatings Micronesia already employs fourteen (14) local
15 residents and has empowered two (2) companies with training and product

1 knowledge to become independent dealers; in addition to donating flooring to all
2 of the chemistry labs located within the new John F. Kennedy High School; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Armor Coatings Micronesia, exclusive distributors of Vortex,
4 Granitex, Eco-Meric, Oxygenics, Power Cost Monitors, and Counteract, are in the
5 business of strengthening and protecting our homes, commercial and public
6 buildings including our schools, areas that we –including our children- frequent;

8 **WHEREAS**, This is the perfect progression for two men who have spent
9 their lives protecting and serving our community in various capacities of law
10 enforcement: Jose, who started his law enforcement career as a Corrections Officer
11 has been patrolling Guam’s streets now for the past decade as a Police Officer I in
12 the Guam Police Department. John, in order take on the President and Managing
13 Director’s role, has become a Police Reservist with GPD. John is also a member of
14 Guam’s National Guard and has served a tour in Afghanistan, respectively; and
