WHEREAS, Mr. Paolo Benigno "Bam" A. Aquino was chosen by the Philippine Consulate and the Filipino Community of Guam as the keynote speaker of the Guam's celebration banquet of the 113th Anniversary of Philippine Independence due to his impressive record of service and outstanding commitment to his community ; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Aquino has been the president of Microventures, Inc. 9 since June 2007, before which he was the managing director since January 2007. 10 Miroventures, Inc. is a social business enterprise that does business development for the poor through its partner micro finance institutions and it currently runs the
 Hapinoy Program which is a full service support program for micro entrepreneurs
 in the Philippine countryside; and

WHEREAS, he has also been the president of the TAYO Foundation since
2006 which oversees the yearly search for the most outstanding youth
organizations in the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, "Bam" was the host of Start-up, a television show for budding
entrepreneurs from November 2008 to August 2009; the host of Yspeak, Studio 23,
a youth-oriented debate show from July 2006 to February 2007, and the host of
Breakfast at Studio 23 which was a youth-oriented morning talk show from April
2001 to July 2006 on the Philippine's premier news channel ABS-CBM; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Aquino was the editor of the ASEAN 40th Anniversary book that focuses on young achievers in the region called *Young Southeast Asia* which was published in 2007; and

WHEREAS, he was the president of Megamobile, Inc., a mobile solutions
 provider for small and medium enterprises from September 2006 to February 2008;
 and

WHEREAS, Mr. Paolo Benigno "Bam" A. Aquino was also the Chairman
and Chief executive Officer of the National Youth Commission which is the chief
youth policy-making arm of the Philippine government from February 2003 to
February 2006 and formerly served as the Commissioner-at-large in the same
commission from May 2001 prior to his appointment as Chairman; and

WHEREAS, he was involved with rehabilitation centers for abused and neglected children, disaster management, relief operations and volunteer recruitment through Special Projects Group of the ABS-CBN Foundation from May 1999 to May 2000; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Paolo Benigno "Bam" A. Aquino was also a standout 1 student throughout his academic life, graduating as valedictorian from both Ateneo 2 de Manila Grade School and Ateneo de Manila High School. He graduated with a 3 Bachelor of Science in Management Engineering from Ateneo de Manila 4 University as class valedictorian with summa cum laude honors. "Bam" also 5 attended the Ateneo de Manila Law School from 2000 to 2001 and the Kennedy 6 School of Government at Harvard University for an Executive Education Program 7 on Public Policy and Leadership in December 2008; and 8

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Paolo Benigno "Bam" A. Aquino has been the recipient of
10 many awards and recognitions throughout his young life; and

WHEREAS, he was named as one of the "Ten Outstanding Young Men of the Philippines 2010" by the Philippine Jaycees; Co-Finalist for the "Ernst and Young Entrepreneur of the Year 2010;" "PLDT Bossing Co-Awardee 2010" in the Retail Financing Category, awarded by the PLDT; "GONegosyo Inspiring Young Entrepreneur 2010," awarded by GoNegosyo; "Young Global Leader" by the World Economic Forum in Canada in 2006; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Aquino has also been a member of the board of the Coca-17 Cola Foundation and Rags2Riches, Inc. since September 2007; a member of Asia 18 Society's Asia 21 Young Leader's Forum since February 2006; member of the 19 Board of Trustees for Venture for Fund-Raising since 2002; he served as the 20 ambassador for the Haribon Foundation from March 2004 to March 2006; as 21 chairman of the ASEAN Ministerial Meeting on Youth in Manila, Philippines in 22 August 2003; and as spokesperson of The Children's Hour to raise resources for 23 poor children through donations from 2002 to 2004;; and 24

WHEREAS, he served as president of the Ateneo de Manila University student council, Sanggunian ng mga Mag-aaral from 1998 to 1999; was a founding member and constitutional chairman of the National union of Catholic Student Councils; and was recognized as "Jose Rizal Most Outstanding Model Student of
 the Philippines" in 1999 and as one of the "Merit Top Ten College Co-eds" in
 1999; and now, therefore be it
