RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING THE DOMINO LUX (DLX) INTERNATIONAL FRATERNITY, GUAM CHAPTER, ON THE OCCASION OF CELEBRATING ITS THIRD (3RD) ANNIVERSARY; ACKNOWLEDGING THAT DOMINO LUX IS ONE OF THE FASTEST GROWING LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS ON ISLAND HAVING INCREASED ITS MEMBERSHIP BY MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY (550) SINCE ITS ESTABLISHMENT; AND EXTENDING A DANGKOLO' NA SI YU'OS MA'ASE' AND MARAMING SALAMAT PO' TO ALL ITS BROTHERHOOD MEMBERS FOR THEIR ACTIVE INVOLVEMENT THROUGHOUT THE ISLAND COMMUNITY AND SUPPORT FOR THE PEOPLE OF GUAM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

1 **WHEREAS,** Domino Lux (DLX) Fraternity is an elite international
2 fraternity established for the purposes of strategically focusing on the
3 promotion of the DLX core values of Brotherhood, Intellectual, Cultural,
4 Physical and Spiritual Welfare of its members; and

5 **WHEREAS,** Domino Lux Fraternity was originally founded on
6 September 20, 1974 in De La Salle University, Manila, Philippines by 14

1 aspiring professionals, to extend the camaraderie amongst its members in
2 college and throughout life. Subsequently, one of the brothers established the
3 Domino Lux International Fraternity in an effort to share its legacy and values
4 worldwide and to further promote the brotherhood in the advancement of
5 personal and professional success; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Domino Lux Fraternity advocates and promotes the
7 symbolism of brotherhood, to include: individualism within the framework of
8 cooperation, lifetime friendship amongst its members, provide support and
9 encouragement in the personal and professional endeavors of its members,
10 promote the strength and foundation of the family as the core to a successful
11 and fruitful life, and promotes the direct involvement of its members in their
12 participation in and support of local community activities; and

13 **WHEREAS,** Domino Lux Fraternity's guiding principles center on the
14 following goals: 1. To promote the spirit of camaraderie among the members;
15 2. To inculcate in every member the value of scholarship, and acts as a
16 guiding force in his/her pursuit of chosen career, making him/her fully
17 prepared for his/her current and future state; 3. To improve the social
18 attitudes and conduct of each member; 4. To provide a medium in developing
19 and polishing the potentialities in every member; 5. To develop the physical
20 and mental well-being of each member; and, 6. To uplift spiritual awareness
21 in every member to achieve a well rounded personality; and

22 **WHEREAS,** Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, was
23 informally established on Guam on June 18, 2008, with Eighteen (18) Chapter

1 Original Founding Members, and in just a short time span of three (3) years
2 has grown in its membership to more than 550 brothers, which has been
3 credited much to the ability of each of its individual members to aggressively
4 recruit new members because of the organization's dynamic support
5 internally of each other and of its support to the island community; with the
6 Guam Chapter being recognized as the Domino Lux International Fraternity
7 Headquarters; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, will
9 soon be venturing on expanding its foundational base to include the
10 establishment of a Domino Lux International Sorority, Guam, which will
11 similarly promote and advocate its core values and principles amongst the
12 female population on island in the advancement of sisterhood and
13 community; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, since
15 its initial establishment has extended tremendous support amongst its
16 members and the Guam community to include, but not limited to the
17 following activities: regular gatherings of its members for friendship; sponsor
18 DLX Annual Red Carpet Ball to celebrate founding day amongst brothers and
19 family members; participation of its members in numerous local sports
20 activities, i.e. basketball, softball, billiards, and others; regular family day
21 gatherings; conducting an annual religious retreat for its members during
22 Lent; sponsoring sports clinics for the island's youths; participating in the
23 cleaning and painting of one of Guam's public middle schools; providing

1 monetary donation to the Japan Earthquake Relief Effort; sponsor DLX
2 Annual Red Carpet Ball fundraisers with proceeds being distributed to
3 several of Guam's non-profit community organizations; sponsoring medical
4 fundraisers in support of family members; and numerous other events and
5 activities highlighting the active support and contribution that Domino Lux
6 International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, provides the people of Guam; now
7 therefore be it

8 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu na*
9 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby on behalf of the people of Guam recognize,
10 acknowledge, and congratulate Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam,
11 on the occasion of its Third (3rd) Anniversary celebration, and extends its best
12 wishes for continues success in its future endeavors; and; and be it further

13 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Unu na*
14 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam extend a
15 **Dangkolo' Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase'** and **Maraming Salamat Po'** in expressing
16 appreciation to the Guam Chapter Original Founding Members and to each of
17 the members of Domino Lux International Fraternity, Guam Chapter, for the
18 support they provide internally to its members and their families, and
19 particularly, for its overwhelming support and tremendous contribution to
20 the island community during its short time of existence; and be it further

21 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify and the Chairperson of the
22 Committee on Rules certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to the
