1            **BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN**

3            **WHEREAS**, forty years ago, sometime in 1971, the first group of Korean  
4            nationals came to Guam; and

5            **WHEREAS**, Korean Americans through their hard work and  
6            perseverance successfully settled on the island and made significant  
7            contributions to the economy of Guam; and

8            **WHEREAS**, the Korean Association of Guam (KAG) was established on  
9            October 1973 by many prominent business leaders who served as its founding  
10           members;

11           **WHEREAS**, the 26th Korean Association of Guam is composed of its  
12           President, Sang Rok Oh, Vice-President, Edward K. Choi, Director for General  
13           Affairs, Park Hyun Soo, Director for Finance, Charles J. Kim, Director for  
14           Operations, Hyung Gon Kim, Director for Public Relations, Randy Jung,

1 Director for Sports, Jeon Tae Young, Director for Education, Jong Won Lee,
