WHEREAS, as part of that corporate philosophy, Dan has embraced the island community and local culture by adopting and fostering values such as *inafa'maolek*, *chenchule'*, and *respetu* for incorporation in business practices to actively promote the well being of the community; and

WHEREAS, in addition to introducing and providing cutting-edge services and products for Guam's consumers, Dan has created a corporate philosophy of giving back to the community through active employee volunteerism and major corporate philanthropy with support to numerous, worthy, not-for-profit organizations that are doing excellent work for the island and its residents.
