**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA' TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:**

- 1           **WHEREAS**, Major David Aguon Reyes was born on May 5, 1957 to the late Mr.
- 2           Francisco San Agustin and Mrs. Concepcion Aguon Reyes; and
- 3           **WHEREAS**, Major Reyes is married to Cecille Cruz Reyes and they have four
- 4           children; Ryan, Jocelyn Derrick and Joel, and seven grandchildren; and
- 5           **WHEREAS**, Major Reyes resides in the beautiful village of Talofofu; and
- 6           **WHEREAS**, began his thirty year career in the Customs and Quarantine Agency
- 7           as a Customs Officer I in April, 1982; and
- 8           **WHEREAS**, Major Reyes was then promoted to rank of Customs Officer III in
- 9           October 1996 and then subsequently promoted in April 1997, to the rank of Customs
- 10          Officer Supervisor (Lieutenant); and

11           **WHEREAS**, from April 1997 to October 2006, Major Reyes served as a Supervisor  
12 within the different divisions of the Customs & Quarantine Agency; and

13           **WHEREAS**, after working for over twenty-four (24) years with Customs, Major  
14 Reyes was then promoted on October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2006 to his present rank of Assistant Chief  
15 (Major), where for the last six years, he has served as the Assistant Chief for the Special  
16 Enforcement Division, the Maritime & Cargo Division, the Inspection & Control  
17 Division, and finally, the Logistics & Support Division; and

18           **WHEREAS**, Major Reyes has also served as Acting Chief of Customs on  
19 numerous occasions whenever called upon to perform this duty; and

20           **WHEREAS**, Major Reyes' duties and responsibilities have demanded many  
21 tireless hours, shift changes, and time away from his family especially during  
22 Typhoons, Earthquakes, and other emergencies in which he ensured the accountability  
23 and serviceability of his division before that of his family; and

24           **WHEREAS**, Major Reyes' distinguished service in Customs is displayed by the  
25 following nomination and awards received: nominated as Officer of the second Quarter;  
26 April to June of 1985; nominated as Officer of the first Quarter; January to March, 1995;  
27 nominated and was recipient of Officer of the third Quarter; July to September 1995;  
28 nominated and was recipient of Officer of the second Quarter; April to June, 1996;  
29 nominated and was recipient of the Customs Officer Supervisor of the Year; 1997;  
30 recipient of the Governors Award of Excellence: 1997 Excel Supervisor of the Year;

31 recipient of CQA Section of Year; Maritime Section Supervisor 1998; nominated as one  
32 of the Top 5 Supervisors of the Year for Customs in 2000; completed numerous Local &  
33 Federal trainings throughout his 30 Year career ; and

34         **WHEREAS**, Major Reyes' dedication to his duty in Customs, being a  
35 hardworking farmer, a loving spouse and a father to his family are what empowers  
36 Major Reyes to excel and succeed in all he does; and

37         **WHEREAS**, Major Reyes is also a hard working avid farmer where his passion  
38 for farming is what drives him in making his decision to retire from Customs and  
39 finally be his own "boss"; and

40         **WHEREAS**, Major Reyes is also known for the many fiestas he has held at his  
41 family home and takes pride in his gatherings and his friendship with many fellow  
42 officers, friends and family; now, therefore be it
