- 5 October 11, 2002 and Ledge Light Technologies, Inc. is licensed to do
- 6 business in the Island of Guam and also serves the Commonwealth of the
- 7 Northern Mariana Islands and American Samoa; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Ledge Light Technologies, Inc. serves its clients by
- 9 creating technology-based solutions in three key areas: information
- technology, software engineering and custom application solutions and
- 11 Ledge Light Technologies, Inc has since expanded to include human
- resource services to include staffing, consulting, training and development
- 13 and drug testing; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the mission of Ledge Light Technologies, Inc. is to
- 15 provide the highest quality service, utilizing the latest methods and

- technology available while minimizing costs, providing on-time
- 2 performance, improving efficiencies and effectiveness for the organizations
- 3 clients it serves; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the cadre of professionals of Ledge Light Technologies,
- 5 Inc. have over Twenty-Eight (28) years of experience managing various
- 6 multi-million dollar projects and multi-year contracts for federal, state and
- 7 territorial governments as well as the private sector; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the experiences of Ledge Light Technologies, Inc.
- 9 include working with federal grants in the administration, implementation
- and compliance in various government programs, i.e. transportation,
- education, finance, housing and labor; and
- WHEREAS, the initial engagement of Ledge Light Technologies, Inc.
- on Guam began with the Department of Public Works (DPW) and Office
- 14 Highway Safety (OHS) began in 2004. The initial five (5) year contract with
- the DPW and OHS consisted of project management, grant application
- development and preparation, computer system design, application
- 17 development, implementation, testing, deployment, help desk,
- maintenance, and enhancements of an Islandwide Traffic Safety
- 19 Information System; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Ledge Light Technologies, Inc. facilitated the
- 21 development of the Islandwide Traffic Safety Information System
- 22 comprised of a crash reporting system, electronic citation system,

emergency medical services system, roadway system, DPW data analysis 1 2 tool, interface to driver and vehicle data, and reporting components; and WHEREAS, Ledge Light Technologies, Inc. has successfully 3 interfaced various Government of Guam agencies such as DPW, Guam 4 Police Department (GPD), Department of Revenue and Taxation, Guam 5 Memorial Hospital, Guam International Airport Authority and the 6 Department of Public Health and Social Services in articulating their 7 requirements and in preparing the annual grant application. The grant 8 9 applications prepared by Ledge Light Technologies, Inc has provided over Two Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,800,000) to DPW and 10 OHS; and 11 WHEREAS, Ledge Light Technologies, Inc. recently installed an 12 electronic Citation System for GPD and the Superior Court of Guam. This 13 system allows a GPD Officer to issue an electronic traffic violation in their 14 15 police car and transmit the data over a wireless network through the 16 Government of Guam Wide Area Network (GGWAN) to the Superior 17 Court Database at the Department of Administration (DOA). With the 18 system being so successful Ledge Light Technologies, Inc has been 19 awarded a three (3) years extension on its current contract; and 20 WHEREAS, Ledge Light Technologies, Inc recognizing the 21 opportunities and potential of the Pacific Region decided to open Ledge Light Technologies Pacific and the appointment of Ms. Zita Pangelinan as 22

Chief Operating Officer for the Pacific Region; and
