2 Phelps, who recognized the importance of providing youth oriented programs and services
3 on Island; and

6 **WHEREAS**, since its creation, Sanctuary has remained at the forefront of providing
7 comprehensive services to runaway, homeless and troubled youth and their families;
8 continually expanding the scope of services to the local population and addressing
9 emergent issue that our local youth face; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Incorporated continuously strives to provide support
11 programs that now include a twenty four (24) hour Crisis Hotline, COED Emergency
12 Shelter, Rural Host Homes Demonstration Project, Transitional Living Program, *Sagan*
13 *Na'Homlo Para I Manhoben* for youth battling chemical dependency, case Management

1 Services, *Ayuda Para I Komunidat* AmeriCorps Program, Street Outreach Program,
2 Relationship Intelligence Project, Youth Embracing Sanctuary (YES) Crew positive youth
3 development program, *Fan Macho'cho* Economic Development-Aquaculture and Healing
4 Farms Organic Farming Project, Parenting Skills and Support group, Adult Anger
5 Management, Youth Anger Management, Tobacco Cessation, Self Esteem, drug and alcohol
6 education and treatment groups HIV/STD testing and education; and,

7 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary encourages island residents to join in various events
8 throughout the month of November to help educate others about Sanctuary's services; and

9 **WHEREAS**, November 2011 will mark the Fortieth (40th) Anniversary of Sanctuary,
